Focus Question(s):

- What people, places, or events inspired Cezanne's art?
- What sets him apart from other artists of his time?

In the galleries:

- Take photos (where allowed) or make sketches, to discuss later.
- Play “I spy” in each room.
- Choose a painting and take turns naming something you observe until you run out of things.
- Choose a painting and tell a story based on what you see.
- What was your favorite piece in the room? Why?
- Choose a painting and observe for a full 5 minutes. How was this experience different than a quick glance?
- Jot down any questions that come up about the history and geography that you encounter in the exhibition so you can do more research when you get home.
- In the gift shop, buy a postcard of your favorite painting and send it to someone, telling them about your trip to the gallery.

Follow-Up Activities/Discussion:

- Discuss what people, places, or events inspired and influenced Cezanne's work.
- Create a trailer or poster advertising the exhibition.
- Write a review of the exhibition.
- Write a story inspired by one of Cezanne's paintings.
- Paint a copy of one of Cezanne's paintings that you took a photo of in the gallery.
- Where is your favorite place to sit and think or observe? Return to this place often to photograph it, paint it, or draw it in different seasons and in different media.
- Set up your own still life using objects like jugs, bowls, textiles, bottles, flowers, and, of course, apples.
