
Age Recommendation: 10+ (there is lots of reading involved)

Focus Question(s):

- What made Alexander so great?

In the galleries:

- Read the signage on the wall or in the exhibition guide when entering each new theme (6 total). Fold a piece of printer paper into thirds and write the caption for each room at the top. Include any or all of the following as you take notes:
 - Jot down any questions that come up about the history and geography that you encounter in the exhibition so you can do more research when you get home.
 - List the legends attributed to Alexander.
 - List peoples conquered by Alenxander.
 - What mythical creatures did Alexander come up against?
- In the gift shop, buy a postcard and send it to someone, telling them about your trip to the exhibition.



Follow-Up Activities/Discussion:

- Discuss your answer to the focus question as well as any interesting things that came up in your notes.
